

# The Unknowns

Men who were killed but their bodies were never recovered for burial or were not identified at the time of burial are commemorated on the Menin Gate Memorial to the missing if they went missing in Belgium or on the Vimy Memorial if they went missing in France.

The Menin Gate Memorial contains the names of fifty two men of the 60th. The Vimy memorial contains the names of sixty four.

There are ten graves that commemorate an unknown man of the 60th Battalion
