During the night 6/1: two and one half Companies and the Lewis gun detachments were relieved by the 31 st B ⁿ and moved to Chateau Belge, B ⁿ HQs moving into Zillebete Bend. Remainder of B ⁿ 's Coy. continued to hold Warrington beyond area and northern end of Hill St. | unsettled WJG |
| | 7/6/16 | | Intermittent shelling by enemy throughout the day but quiet on the whole. During the night two trenches still held by us were taken over by the 52 nd B ⁿ who also relieved B ⁿ HQs in Zillebete Bend and our Coys at Belge Chateau and the whole B ⁿ moved to Camp E. Relief completed 11:30 p.m. Our total casualties from June 2 nd to June 7 th inclusive were 11 Officers 334 O.R. | Fine WJG |
