The remainder remaining in billets here and will move up tomorrow. Distance Enderswolds to Loere 4 1/2 miles. Party arrived at 3.00 pm. Had meal from kitchen at noon. Near Baillens = No casualties.</i>	<i>Weather fine, mild</i>
<i>Loere</i>	<i>2/5/16</i>	<i>9.30 am</i>	<i>Remainder of H.Q.s & 2 boys under Maj Evans left at 9.00 pm for Loere and arrived with only one casualty at 3.00 pm and went into billets. 24th Bn. Co. in billets in Loere and were standing to as there were rumors of a threatened attack.</i>	<i>MBC</i>

	<i>10/3/16</i>	<i>10 am</i>	<i>Details of H.Q.s and 2nd Coy marched from billets in Loere via Baillens & Hétie to Div Area north of Hétie & went into billets. C.O. sent to Hospital at front town. B & D boys came out of trenches & went into billets at Loere for night.</i>	<i>Dr. Cold</i>
	<i>11/3/16</i>	<i>11 am</i>	<i>H.Q.s & 2 Coy under Maj Evans moved via Baillens & Hétie to Div Area. Having completed their tour of instruction in trenches. Entire 9th Bde. Com now assembled in Edge area to complete training (exception 52nd Bn who have taken over sector of front line)</i>	<i>Drill Cold</i>
