Rt. Bde. Trench Map.

1. The Battalion will be relieved by the 5th C.M.R. on the night of April 13th.
2. Seventeen guides (4 from each Co. and 1 from H.Qrs) will meet the incoming Battalion at Transport Farm at 8.45 p.m. and lead their platoons to new quarters. 2 Co'ys for MAPLE COPSE, moving via, PROMENADE, ZILLEBEKE St & DURHAM Ave, and two Co'ys and H.Qrs for RAILWAY DUGOUTS direct across field.
3. "A" & "B" Cos. & H.Qrs. will move off as soon as relieved via Road I 20 A 5.4., thence by road to Camp "D" - G 24.
4. "C" & "D" Cos. will move off as soon as relieved via, BORDER LANE, DORMY HOUSE LANE, PROMENADE to road junction I 20 A 5.4., thence by road to Camp "D" - G 24.
5. One hundred yards to be left between platoons.
6. Baggage of "C" & "D" Cos. must be at Tramway Terminus not later than 8.00 p.m. April 13th.
7. Baggage of "A" & "B" Cos. and H.Qrs to be at Transport Farm not later than 8.00 p.m. April 13th.
8. Machine Guns will be relieved on night of April 12/13th under arrangements made by Brigade Machine Gun Officer.
9. Battalion Bombers will be relieved under arrangements to be made by Brigade Bombing Officer.
10. Trench Mortar Section will be relieved under arrangements of O.C., Trench Mortars.
11. Signallers will arrange their own relief with 5th C.M.R.,
12. Inventories of all trench stores will be made out in triplicate and receipts obtained. One copy will be sent to Brigade Headquarters. /from each Company).
13. One N.C.O. /will be sent on in advance to take over Camp "D" and will report to Capt. Hall, O.M. These N.C.O.'s will meet Companies at cross roads H 14 B 4.8.
14. Reports of relief to be sent to Orderly Room as soon as completed, using cypher word "compait".
15. Route from Transport Farm. Road to "shrapnel" corner, thence steam railway to Tramway Line, which follow to Main Street, KRUISTRAAT, cross roads, H 14 B 4.8 to Camp at G 24.
