Operation Order No. 24,
By Lieut. Col. F. A. Gascoigne,
C. C. 60th Canadian Battalion. *Appendix II*

In the Field,
May 14th, 1916.

1. In accordance with instructions received from the 9th Can. Inf. Brigade, the 60th Can. Battn. will relieve the B.C.R. on the night 15th-16th May. The battalion will parade at 7.30 P.M. on the Battn. Parade Ground in Mass Formation facing North-West, and will form up in the following order from the right:-
"HQ" Details, "B" "A" "D" "G" "D" Companies.
2. Route. Via train to Asylum, thence via B.R. track to Lille Road by Transport Farm to Observatory Ridge. Platoons will proceed at 80 yards distance, from the Asylum.
3. (a) Lewis-Gun Detachment will relieve the detachment of the B.C.R. on the night of 14-15th.

(b) Battalion Bombers and Headquarters Details will proceed with Battalion as far as Transport Farm, whence they will proceed by Zillebeke Street through Maple Copse. Arrangements have been made for guides to meet them at *head of Zillebeke St (Maple Copse)*

(c) Scout Officer, with 8 Scouts and 8 Snipers, will take ~~up~~ over during day of 15th.
4. Companies will arrange to send one Officer and one ^{or} more N.C.O. as Advance Party to take over trench stores during the day of May 15. The usual receipts for the trench stores will be given, one copy to be sent to Brigade Headquarters.
5. *defence schemes*
All ~~advance parties~~ to be taken over.
6. will meet
Guides and platoons and details at Transport Farm and platoons will proceed ~~through~~ ^{via} road to ration dump and ~~to~~ ^{thence} their post.
7. One Scout will be attached, before leaving Camp "A", to each company to act as Guides from the Asylum to Transport Farm.
8. Until further arrangements, all snipers will be under their respective Company Commanders for rations, quarters and discipline, but will be relieved of all duties and working parties and will be under the Scout Officer for disposition and carrying on of their duties.
9. (a) Lewis-Guns and Lewis-Gun Detachment will be subject to the orders of the Company Commander to whose trench they are allotted in the front line.
(b) Lewis-Gun Officer will be responsible that the guns are kept in good order and the disposition of the personnel for work.
10. Until further orders, Companies will occupy the following positions:-
Front Line - Right "A" Company.
 " Left "B" Company.
