

Operation Order No. 13.

O. C. 60th Canadian Battalion,  
In the Field,  
March 9th, 1916.

Reference - Sheets 27 & 28 Belgium & France.

1. Move.

The two Companies of the Battalion at present Billeted in LOCRE will march out on March 10th.

The remainder of the Battalion will billet in LOCRE on the night 10th and 11th and march out on March 11th.

2. Billeting Party.

Lieut. F. W. Wiggins. 2 N.C.O's per Company.  
2 N.C.O's Headquarters.  
5 cyclists.

Party will parade at Battalion Headquarters ready to move at 6.00 a.m. Friday March 10th.

Full kits and rations for 24 hours to be carried.

Party will meet Brigade Billeting Officer at cross road W.12.b.8.4. at 9 a.m.

Cyclist Orderlies from billeting party will meet Companies at road junction W.6.a. central and guide them to billets.

3. First Party.

"A" Co. less details - "C" Co. less details.  
Headquarters less details - Transport less vehicles and horses for two Companies.

Party will march as noted in margin from LOCRE and road junction W.6.a. central., via BAILLEUL. Head of column will pass Battalion Orderly Room at 10 a.m. O.C.'s Companies and Transport Officer will arrange starting times from billets accordingly.

4. Baggage.

Extra Blankets in rolls of 10 must be piled at Company Billets at 8 a.m. Officers' kits to be at same place at same hour.

5. Dress.

Full Marching Order with one blanket in pack.

6. Rations.

A hot meal will be provided from kitchens en route. Company Q.M.S. will make arrangements. "C" Company will draw rations for 30 men of transport section and have cooked in their kitchen. "A" Company will draw for 25 Headquarters details and cook for them.

7. Marching States.

Marching States to be handed to the Adjutant at Battalion Headquarters at 10.00 a.m.
