Operation Order No. 36
By Lt. Colonel F.A. Gascoigne,
O.C. 60th Can. Bn. V.R.C.

In the Field, August 2nd 1916.
Ref. Map. Bel. & France.
Sheet 28, 1/40000.

1. In accordance with instructions received from the 9th Canadian Infantry Brigade, 60th Canadian Battalion will be relieved on the night of August 3/4th at the Bund and strong points, I.H. & I.K. by the 49th Canadian Bn. and will proceed on relief to camp ERIE at ~~.....~~ G.I.I. S. 8.1.
2. Route TRAIN or MARCH route. O.Cs. Companies will arrange rendezvous for their platoons and move off independently by companies.
3. Completion of relief will be reported to Battalion Headquarters at the Bund by code sentence. "O.G.I" received.
4. If proceeding by march route, strict march discipline must be enforced and there must be an officer in the rear of each company.
5. Present quarters must be left clean and a thorough inspection made by company officers by 9.30 p.m. A report being sent in to Battalion H.Q. by 10 p.m. by O.C. Companies that they are satisfied.
6. (a) Care should be taken to collect all available water tins and have them taken to ration dump by 10 p.m.
(b) All baggage and stores must be collected at dump by 10 p.m.
7. One N.C.O. or man per company and one each from Bombers, Signallers and L.M.G. Section will report to the C.Q.M.S. of their respective companies at camp Erie by 9.30 p.m. 3rd August 1916.
8. Half the 9th Brigade Wearing Party now at Ypres will move as above with the 60th Canadian Battalion and will be attached to them for quarters and rations from the 4th inst. inclusive.
9. C.Q.M.Ss. or guides will meet companies and details on arrival at Camp Erie and guide them to their quarters, no companies or details will occupy any quarters until they have been properly directed to them.
10. Reports to Battalion H.Q. Camp Erie after 2 a.m. 4/8/16.
