Operation Order No. 41.

1. In accordance with orders received from the 9th Can. Inf. Bde., the 60th Battalion will be relieved in the front-line trenches by the 1st Battalion - Royal Warwickshire Regiment - and will proceed by a march route to YPRES, thence by train to CAMP St. Lawrence.

Trench stores will be handed over in the usual manner and receipts taken.

Companies and details will be relieved in accordance with schedule issued to each company and O.Cs. details.

All Company Stores, etc., will be at Ration Dump by 10-30 pm. Water-tins will be collected and left at Dump by 10-30 pm.

Platoons, on relief, will move independently to the train at ASYLUMN, Ypres.

C.Q.M.Ss. will arrange to have hot tea and biscuits for the entire Battalion on arrival at Camp St. Lawrence.

On completion of relief, Bn. HQ will be notified by use of code phrase "C.G. 40 received".
