1. In accordance with orders received from the 9th Can. Inf. Bde. the 60th Can. Bn. will move from Camp "D" to Billets in STEENVOORDE Area.
2. Billetting party will leave "D" Camp at 4.00 p.m. Aug. 26th and will consist of B.Q.M.S. and C.Q.M.Ss. of each Company.
3. The Battalion will parade at 7.45 am. Aug. 27th on the Bn. Parade Ground in Mess facing NORTH EAST - Aug. 27th.  
 Dress - Heavy Marching Order. Helmets strapped on back of pack.  
 Greatcoats and messin in packs.  
 Order of March -----  
 Scouts.  
 Signals.  
 HQ Staff.  
 Pioneers.  
 "A" Coy.  
 "B" Coy.

4. Officers' kits and Company Mess equipment stores, etc., must be ready for loading by 6.45 am sharp.
5. O.C. Coys. and details will hand in a written report on Bn. Parade Ground that lines have been left clean.
6. Each man will carry a Haversack ration and company kitchens will prepare hot tea. Headquarters details are attached to Companies as follows for issue of tea en route:-  
 Signals to "A" Coy.  
 Scouts, Hqrs. Staff and Pioneers to "B" Coy.  
 Bombers to "C" Coy.  
 L.M.G. and Transport to "D" Coy.
7. Company pack animals will follow in rear of their respective companies.
8. Only three men will be allowed to march with each kitchen.
9. Each Officer will detail an Officer to march in rear of the company and all men unable to continue the march must have a pass signed by a Company Officer before being allowed to fall out. This pass must be handed to the Officer in charge of the rear party.
10. Each Company will detail 1 N.C.O. and two men to report to Lieut. Curran at 7.45 on Bn. Parade Ground and these will form, with the police, the rear party.
