that raids were made practically along the whole of our front, and that after our artillery fire had reached its height, Germans were seen moving back from their front to their support lines, it may be inferred that they intended, if their raiding parties were successful, to follow them up with a larger attack. This was rendered abortive by the action of the ~~60th Canadian~~ <sup>60th Canadian</sup> Battalion and the prompt support of the Divisional and Corps Artillery.

I regret to report that the following casualties were suffered by the 60th. Canadian Battalion.
