## **457081 Alfred Scott**

Scott enlisted in the 60<sup>th</sup> Battalion on June 4, 1915. Alfred Scott was a miner in civilian life and was attached for duty with the 177th Tunneling Company of the Royal Engineers when he was reported "missing after action" on June 3, 1916. On July 7, 1917, they found out he had been wounded in the right leg and was taken prisoner. He was held at Stuttgart, Germany. He was released from captivity December 24, 1918 and Struck off Strength April 28, 1919. Scott died April 9, 1946 at Montreal General Hospital, Montreal and is buried in Mount Royal Cemetery, Montreal.
