## **139521 John Joseph Boston**

Originally enlisted with the 75th Battalion, he joined the 60<sup>th</sup> on June 17, 1916 as part of a reinforcing draft from the 75<sup>th</sup> Battalion. He was transferred to the 87<sup>th</sup> on breakup of the 60<sup>th</sup> Battalion. On the 15<sup>th</sup> of August 1917 he was reported missing. On September 28, 1917 it was reported he was a POW being held at Limburg and he was wounded. On January 4, 1918, he was reported to have died of pneumonia at Mulheim a Ruhr. Boston is buried in the Cologne Southern Cemetery in Cologne, Germany. He is commemorated on the honour roll of the 87<sup>th</sup> Battalion.
