3rd Canadian Division

1. In accordance with War Office instructions, copies of which have already been forwarded to you, the 60th Canadian Battalion will be withdrawn forthwith and replaced by the 116th Canadian Battalion, under arrangements to be made by the 3rd Canadian Division.

2. The available personnel of the 60th Canadian Battalion, with the exception of the O.C., Second-in-Command, Adjutant, Quartermaster, R.S.M., R.Q.M.S., Orderly Room Staff, and servants of the above officers, will be disposed of as follows :-

All necessary documents will accompany them, including all documents affecting men awaiting trial by P.C.C.M.

The foregoing figures are approximate only, the intention being that the whole of the available personnel now with the Canadian Corps, except those mentioned, will be dealt with as above.

This personnel will be shown as attached until authority for carrying out documentary transfers is received from D.A.G. Base.

The O.C. 60th Canadian Battalion will make arrangements direct with D.A.G. Base for carrying out such documentary transfers, and disposing of all records affecting personnel, without delay.

3. Casualties who have not yet been struck off the strength will not be disposed of, but will be dealt with under instructions from D.A.G. Base.

4. 1st Line Transport will be handed over to 116th Canadian Battalion.

5. Surplus equipment will be turned over to Ordnance, and all necessary accounting completed under arrangements to be made by the 3rd Canadian Division.

6. Arrangements for the move of the personnel of the 60th Battalion will be made direct between the Divisions concerned.

7. The personnel of Battalion Headquarters, which will not be absorbed, as specified in Par.2., will report to Commandant, Canadian Corps Reinforcement Camp, CALONNE-RICOUART, where they will be accommodated. Sufficient Front Line Transport and drivers will be provided by 3rd Canadian Division to transport officers' kit and Battalion records.
