Operation Order No. 70,

November 5th 1916.

(1) In accordance with orders from the 9th Can. Inf. Bde., (O.O.5.6.), the 60th Canadian Battalion will be relieved by the 52nd Canadian Battalion on the afternoon of 6th November 1916.

(2) "C" Company, 60th Canadian Bn. will be relieved by "A" Company of the 52nd Canadian Bn. and platoons will proceed via DOUAI, ELBE and TERRITORIAL.

"D" Company, 60th Can. Bn. will be relieved by "C" Coy. 52nd Can. Bn. and platoon will proceed via DOUAI, ELBE and TERRITORIAL.

"A" Coy. 60th Can. Bn. will be relieved by "D" Coy. 52nd Can. Bn. and platoons will proceed via BENTATA, BESSAN, MERCIER and TERRITORIAL.

"B" Coy. 60th Canadian Bn. will be relieved by a Coy. of the 58th Canadian Bn. and will proceed via BESSAN, MERCIER and TERRITORIAL.

Battalion Bombers, Lewis Gunners, Signallers; etc., who may be attached to Companies not their own, will proceed out with the Company to which they are attached.

Scouts, Signallers and Runners will proceed via ELBE and TERRITORIAL.

Pioneers, Police and Orderly Room Staff, will move out with the Signallers and Runners.

(3) Companies will re-assemble on the road at 51.c.f.22.d.61 and march into BRAY. Guides will be met at this point.

(4) CARRYING PARTY: "B" Coy. 60th Can. Bn. will carry rations on the evening of the 5th. November for left and Centre front line Companies of the 52nd Can. Bn.

(5) BAGGAGE and STORES: Baggage and Stores will be sent during the afternoon, to MAISON BLANCHE, where they will be taken up by the TRANSPORT. Headquarters will supply a guard over the dump.

Lewis Guns will be left at TERRITORIAL DUMP and taken out by the Transport. The Lewis Gun Sergeant will be responsible that they are properly cared for and loaded and delivered back to their Companies on arrival at BRAY.

(6) COOKS. Company Cooks will clean their kitchens thoroughly after the noon meal is prepared, and carry camp kettles, etc. to MAISON BLANCHE DUMP. From thence, they will proceed under an N.C.O. to be supplied by "B" Company 60th Can. Bn. to the billets at BRAY and have hot tea prepared for the Companies moving in.

(7) ADVANCE PARTY: Each Company will send an N.C.O. and two batmen in advance. This party will report at the Orderly Room at 11.00 a.m.
