November 22nd 1916.

- (1) The 60th Canadian Battalion will relieve the 52nd Canadian Bn. in right sub-section, afternoon of 24th November 1916. (9th Can. Inf. Bde. O.O.....).
- (2) Distribution from right, in front line, "C", "B" and "A" Companies. Close support, "D" Company, and Companies will move into line by shortest routes.
- (3) Relief to commence at 3 p.m. and to finish by 6 p.m.
- (4) Company Commanders will send Officers and N.C.Os. tomorrow, 23-11-16, to make reconnaissance and, on the 24th, will send an advanced party to take over trench stores and remain in trenches until Company arrives.
- (5) Officers of each Company will arrange to occupy two dugouts, instead of one, in Company frontage.
- (6) Signals and Lewis Guns will take over immediately after noon. "B" Company guns will be placed in front line.
- (7) 52nd Can. Bn. Support Company will carry tea rations, evening of 24-11-16, for front line Companies. Regular carrying schedule will be issued - - Support and Reserve Companies.
- (8) Companies moving out, will leave an Officer and N.C.Os. to turn over trench stores and quarters, which must be left absolutely clean.
- (9) Completion of relief will be reported by signal message, "M.O.D. 14 received at.....", and disposition, including Lewis Guns, sent by runner immediately.
