

60th Canadian Battalion Order 74.
(Operation Order)

November 29th, 1916.

Ref. Trench Map, 51 c. N.E. 1/20,000.

- (1) In accordance with 9th Brigade O.C. No. 60, the 60th Canadian Bn. will be relieved by the 52nd Canadian Battalion on the afternoon of 30-11-16, and will proceed to Division Reserve at BRAY.
- (2) Relief to commence at 3.00 p.m. and finish at 6.00 p.m.
- (3) Signals and Lewis Guns will commence relief at 2.00 p.m.
- (4) Companies will march out independently using TERRITORIAL Trench, and platoons will be assembled on the main road at the foot of the trench, for the march into BRAY.
- (5) Lewis Guns will be assembled at MAISON BLANCHE, guard being left over them under Lewis Gun Sergeant, and the sections will march out under Lieut. Hingston.
- (6) Baggage and kitchen stores will be assembled at MAISON BLANCHE by 3.00 p.m. and one man per Company and one Signaller from Headquarters will be left in charge, at the dump and they will see that their own baggage and kitchen stores are properly loaded on the Transport.
- (7) Transport will call at MAISON BLANCHE for baggage and stores.
- (8) Cooks will march out with the first unit leaving, and Headquarters details not required for guards and carrying, will march out under Signalling Officer.
- (9) Each Company and Hqs. will send out an Advance Party to take over billets. These parties will report to Bn. Hqs. at 10.00 a.m. 30/11/16.
- (10) Dugouts and trenches must be left thoroughly clean and sanitary. Receipts to be taken for trench stores.
- (11) "D" Coy., 60th, will supply the parties to carry to front line Companies and to carry rations from dumps to cookhouses evening of 30/11/16.
- (12) Relief complete, to be reported by Signal Message, "Shovels received at", and Commander will report on arrival at BRAY.
