

60th Canadian Bn & VRC Order.
(Operation Order No. 77)

December 17th, 1916.

1. The 60th Canadian Battalion will relieve the 52nd Canadian Bn in the Right Subsection (C.R.) on the evening of 18th December.
2. The two Companies of 60th Battalion in C.R. Subsection will move off when the leading two Companies of the 52nd Canadian Battalion have cleared east of the Rhine Trench. "C" Company, 60th Bn. will also move at this time. "B" Company, 60th Can. Bn., will remain in position. Company Commanders will make their own arrangements for finding out when the 52nd Bn. have arrived in the area. "C" Company will notify L.E.4 when they start to move.
3. Signals will relieve in advance of the companies, as arranged by Signal Officer.
4. Rations night of ^{18th/19th} 18th/19th December will be carried by "A" Coy., 52nd Bn. after they have been relieved.
5. Trench Stores, maps, etc., will be handed over to the incoming unit and receipts taken.
6. Advance party of 1 Officer and 4 N.C.O.s. per Company will proceed to the company being relieved at noon 18/12/16 and remain until their Company comes in.
7. Quarters and dugouts must be inspected by an Officer before moving off and left absolutely clean.
8. Completion of relief to be reported by code phrase "WATER RECEIVED AT"
