Operation Order No. 49,  
By Lieut. Col. F.A. Gascoigne,  
O.C. 60th Canadian Bn. VRC.

In the Field,  
Sept. 21st, 1946.

On instructions from the 9th Canadian Infantry Brigade, the  
Battalion will relieve the 43rd Canadian Bn. and the Manchester Bn. in the  
FABECKGRABEN from 29.a.3.1 to 28.c.0.1, FERME DU MOQUET AND COURCELLETTE  
Maps, 1/5,000 "A" Coy. on the Left, "B" Centre, "D" on the Right, "C"  
in the CHALK MOUND. 52nd Bn. will be on our Right.

A Post will be established at R.28.b.4.2., another at R.28.c.4.8.  
Trenches will be dug and consolidated between R.28.c.3.6. and R.28.c.2.1, ~~the~~  
thence Westerly, connecting up with the Imperial Troops on our left.  
A block will also be established in the ~~xxxxxxx~~ High Trench in R.28.c.0.3.  
Major O'Donahoe will have charge of the front line Companies. ~~xxxxxxx~~

Reports to be sent to Bn. Headquarters in CENTRE WAY, R.34.d.4.6.

Battalion will parade ready to march off at 6:00 pm:100 yards  
interval to be left between Companies. Packs will be left at the CHALK PITS.
