In the Field, Sept. 25/16.

1. The Battalion, on instructions from the Brigade, will continue its march to TOUTENCOURT today and head of the column will leave the junction of the CONTAY-WARLOY ROAD and Road leading to the Transport Lines at 12.00 noon sharp today. Companies must be formed up ready to take their place in line by 11.45 am.

Order of march Scouts, Signallers, Bombers, other Headquarters Details, "B", "C" "D" "A" Companies.

Police and Medical Unit will march in rear and look after stragglers.

2. Officers' baggage must be ready by 10.00 am. --- 11.00 am.

3. Rations.

Men will carry a haversack rations and will be given a hot meal tonight.

4. Discipline.

Utmost discipline must be maintained on the line of march and men must not be allowed to fall out of the ranks at any halt except the usual ten minutes rest.

Billets must be left clean in every way.
