Battalion Order No. 48, 53

In the Field, Sept. 28th, 1916.

On instructions from the 9th Canadian Infantry Bde., the Battalion will continue its march to Bouzincourt tomorrow, September 29th, starting point two hundred (200) yards south of Headquarters; time 1.30 P.M. route via Vadencourt, where Battalion will join the other three battalions of the Brigade.

Order of March :-

Scouts, Signallers and Runners, Bombers, Headquarters Details, "D" "A" "B" "C" Companies.

Police and Medical Staff will march in rear and pick up stragglers.

Band will fall in between "D" and "A" Companies.

Officers' Baggage and kitchens must be ready by 12.30 pm.

Billets must be left clean and reports to this effect must be handed in to the Orderly Room.

Lieut. F. W. Wiggins and the five Company Quartermaster Sergeants will form an advance billeting party.

Usual march discipline must be observed en route.
