Quiet in the morning between 2.30 and 4.00 p.m. Enemy put over 29 heavy and 40 light Trench Mortars on front line supports of our Right Support Company, also four air burst Trench Mortars at Junction of NOUAI and front line. He was also active with rifle grenades at the same time. Our patrols active during night. Considerable aeroplane activity during the morning.	Fine.
	12/12/16.		Comparatively quiet day. A few rounds of gunfire on our Right Support in the morning. Enemy fairly active with rifle grenades. At 1.00 p.m. a deserter came over to our lines at a point just South of Sap 35 d. about A. 16. a. 7.2. He belonged to the 3rd Battalion, N. I. R. Relieved by 52nd Canadian Bn.	
	13/12/16.		Bn. Headquarters at MAISON BLANCHE. "A" Coy. Left Sub-section (C.2), supporting 43rd Bn. xxxx two platoons in MOWCOP, two Platoons at VISTULA. "D" Coy., supporting 43rd Bn. in VISTULA, and "B" Coy., supporting 52nd Bn. BENTATA, "C" Coy. supporting 52nd Bn. ELBE SHELTERS. Comparatively quiet day. Our artillery, including heavy Trench Mortar, fairly active.
