8/10.16.

"B" "D" and "A" Company made 1 Trip. "B" and "D" Coys. attached to the 58th & 43rd Battalions respectively and moved to forward trenches to support attack of these Battalions following morning. Remainder of Bn. and HQ. did not move.

The 4th Bn. Inf. Bde. was in the attack from M. 15. to 6.1 to WEST MIRAumont RD.

At 4.50 am REGINA Trench attacked, 9th Bde. having the 58th and 43rd attacking, with one Coy. each of the 60th in close support; balance of 60th in support in SUGAR TRENCH and 52nd Bn. in 15 Central. At noon called upon to send two Sec'ns. Bn. Bombers to support R.O.R. who had obtained a lodgment in REGINA TRENCH where it crosses WEST MIRAumont ROAD. At 3.00 pm received orders to move balance of 60th Bn. up and relieve 58th and 43rd Battalions. This order afterwards cancelled and orders received for "B" and "D" Coys. to take over front line from 43rd and 58th Bns. OC 60th Bn. took command of the line with the remainder of the 58th and 43rd Bns. in close support, "A" and "C" Coys. of the 60th staying where they were.

OC and Adjutant moved to Headquarters, OUCHELLETTE, R. 30. a. 2-2 1/2, at 6.00 pm, leaving Second in Command in charge of the balance of the Bn. in SUGAR TRENCH.

9/10.16.

Bn. Headquarters at OUCHELLETTE until relieved by the 5th Canadian Bn. night of 9th/10th of October. During day, Support Companies supplied stretcher parties to carry wounded down to collecting station. On relief, Companies marched independently to bivouacs on TARA HILL.

10/10.16.

Bn. paraded at 1.00 pm, moved to ~~BRICKFIELDS~~ bivouacs, BRICKFIELDS.
