

60th Canadian Battalion Order #80.
(Operation Order).

January 9th 1917.

Ref. Trench Map BOULINCOURT, 1/10,000.

(1) In accordance with 9th Ed. O.C. No. 67, the 60th Canadian Bn. will relieve the 52nd Canadian Bn. on the afternoon of January 11th 1917, in the front line trenches.

(2) The two Companies of the 60th. Can. Bn. in C.2 sub-section, will move off when the leading two Companies of the 52th. Can. Bn. have cleared east of the RHINE TRENCH. "D" Coy. 60th Can. Bn. will relieve the "C" Coy. 60th. in Left Support. "C" Co. will then relieve the Right Front Line Coy. 52nd Can. Bn. "B" Co. 60th. will move as soon as the 52th Bn. clears east of the RHINE TRENCH, and will relieve the Centre Front Line Coy. of the 52nd Can. Bn. "A" Co. 60th. will relieve the Left Front Line Company of the 52nd Can. Bn.

(3) One Company of the 52nd Can. Bn. will remain in Right Support and one will move into Reserve.

(4) Signallers, Runners and Scouts, will relieve in advance of the Companies, as will be arranged by their Officers. Lewis Guns will be relieved arrangement between Company Commanders.

(5) Rations night of January 11/12th. will be carried by 52nd Bn. Company in Reserve, after having been relieved.

(6) Advance party of 1 Officer and 2 N.C.Os. per company will proceed to the Company they are relieving, at noon January 11th., and remain with them until their own Company comes in. *Lieut. Brown will take one for headquarters with the D.C.M.*

(7) Trench maps, stores, etc., will be handed over to the incoming unit and receipts taken.

(8) No rubber boots, must, under any circumstances, be taken out of the sub-section. *100 pairs of rubber boots will be at Elbe Shelters for men going out to posts, as formerly.*

(9) Quarters and dugouts must be inspected by Officer before making off, and left absolutely clean, special attention being paid to kitchens, both Officers and men.

(10). Completion of relief will be reported by code message "11/17".
