

OPERATION ORDER NO. 83In the Field,
28/1/17.Ref. Map. ROCLINCOURT, 51c, S.E., 1/10,000.

1. 52nd Canadian Battalion will relieve 60th Canadian Battalion in front trenches tomorrow, January 29th.
2. On relief, "A" Coy. will move into Support of the 43rd Bn. in VISTULA and MOWCOP; "D" Coy. into Reserve of the 43rd Bn. in the RHINE SHELTERS; "C" Coy. into Reserve of 52nd Bn. at SAPPER SHELTERS and "B" Coy. into Left Support of 52nd Bn. Scouts, Snipers and Headquarters Details will move to MAISON BLANCHE as soon as relief is complete.
3. The Companies of the 43rd Bn. in Left Support and in Reserve will not move until they have been relieved by Companies of the 60th Bn.
4. Each Company will send an Officer and a suitable number of N.G.O's on the afternoon of January 29th to take over from the outgoing Coys. and these will see that dugouts, kitchens and lines are clean and sanitary before they sign a receipt.
5. The Company of the 43rd Bn. in Reserve will carry rations for 52nd Bn. from dump to the kitchens on the night of Jan. 29th.
C "B" Company, 60th, after it has moved into Reserve in SAPPER SHELTERS, will carry rations from kitchens to the front line and Support Coys.
6. All gumboots, lumberman's socks, and trench stores, will be carefully checked, and receipt obtained in duplicate, one copy being sent to Bn. Headquarters by noon, 30th inst. Such articles as Very Pistols, Signal Pistols, wiring gloves, wire cutters, etc., are not trench stores and will be taken out by the Companies.

7. Thigh ~~boots~~ must not be taken out of the Right Sub-Section. Companies moving to Left Sub-Section will be supplied with boots which are already in that sub-Section.
8. Bombing Officer will proceed to MAISON BLANCHE afternoon of Jan. 29th and take over Headquarters from the 43rd Battalion.
9. All trenches, dugouts, company kitchens and Officers' kitchens, must be left clean and in a sanitary condition. Company Officers will be responsible for their part of this and the Signal Officer for Headquarters.
10. B.S.M. will arrange carrying parties from Headquarters' Details for H.Q. Stores, et c., which can be taken to MAISON BLANCHE EARLY in early in afternoon.
11. Completion of relief will be reported to Bn. HQ. by code message "19/15" followed by time.
